

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

We are pleased to be able to provide scholarship awards to students in Clarkston schools. The Clarkston Education Foundation (CEF) was established in 2002 with the purpose of enhancing education in Clarkston schools. We value education and we want to make an investment in your future.

Scholarship recipients may pursue two-year or four-year courses of instruction leading to a bachelor's degree, professional or technical degree, or any other course of instruction meeting the approval of the CEF Board of Directors.

Please be sure that you have a complete packet that includes a four-page application, a guidance counselor evaluation form and a confidential evaluation form.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Applications must be received by the Clarkston Education Foundation by April 1, (not postmarked by that date). Send completed applications to:

A completed scholarship application includes:

1. **The Application Form.** Answer all questions on the application. Check to see that all the blanks have been completed with either the information or N/A (not applicable).
2. **The Guidance Counselor** evaluation, sealed in a confidential envelope.
3. **School Transcript** showing your cumulative GPA.
4. **The Confidential Evaluation**, sealed in a confidential envelope. This may be completed by a person of your choice. It may be a teacher, neighbor, employer, etc.

AWARDS: Award recipients will be announced in early May. Written notification will be sent to all applicants by May 15. Upon confirmation of full-time status, payments will be made to the recipient's educational institution in equal payments. Recipients are required to furnish CEF any information requested.
